

**Niwot Elementary School's  
PTAC General Meeting Minutes  
Tuesday, February 21, 2017**

**OPENING**

The meeting was called to order by President Donna Blondeau at 7:04 pm with seven members present, along with Principal, Nancy Pitz.

**PRINCIPAL UPDATE: NANCY PITZ**

Michelle Coleman (5<sup>th</sup> grade) is resigning as of April 5<sup>th</sup>. Her husband accepted a job in Rhode Island. Mrs. Coleman will be back for a few shadow dates after spring break. The job posting for her position will post tomorrow. Her replacement will be considered a long-term sub. Interviews will most likely take place over the next two weeks. An email will go out to notify the NES community. Ricki Frea asked if interviews will be for a permanent replacement or for a sub. Nancy explained When hiring a *late start* teacher the position is considered non-renewal, but the teacher can be rehired permanently in the formal hiring process for next year.

**MAKER SPACE UPDATE**

Mrs. Sherwood prioritized things she wanted. John Freeman, 4<sup>th</sup> grade parent, donated 10 iPads. Some will be used for Maker Space, some for the STEM Lab. All came with cases and keyboards, and are the latest versions. Ricki asked Nancy

to share what the Maker Space will be used for and by whom. Nancy explained the idea behind Maker Space is providing students prototypes, puzzles, questions, and materials to solve problems using technology, legos, and discovery materials. Maker Space will be utilized during library time. Teachers can bring students to Maker Space during other times also. There will be many things available from Qtips to iPads. Basically, anything that might be used to create may be there. Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade is the audience. Mrs. Pitz is proud of Mrs. Sherwood for embracing Maker Space. It enhances the Library.

## **CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**

This summer construction work for all outside projects--playground reconfiguring, parking, Kiss & Catch will be done. Anything planned for outside will be done May through July. Inside work will be done next year, with the exception of entrance security that will be completed this year. Money to do these construction projects comes from the recently approved bond measure. As a result of this construction, there will be no summer camps for the next two years at NES. An email with links to where summer camps will be held was sent to NES families.

## **PRESIDENT UPDATE: DONNA BLONDEAU**

Motion to approve January meeting minutes made, seconded, approved.

Donna called for a vote to pass bylaw amendments—those present voted and unanimously passed.

Donna restated nominations for new board members Cathy Caparelli (Treasurer) and Julie Stenz (Recording Secretary) were voted on and confirmed unanimously.

Nomination of Eve Bonn for Financial Secretary made, seconded, and unanimously passed.

## **BYLAW AMENDMENTS**

General idea is that the bylaws are being updated to allow for two different people to do the job of Treasurer and Financial Secretary. Cathy is doing an amazing job of capturing fees and budgeting set up. Financial Secretary, Eve Bonn, deals with cash, checks, teacher requests, and hands-on tasks. Treasurer is a large job and this is a great solution. Changes to bylaws allow for one Treasurer and adds flexibility for two people to do the job. The Nominating Committee section was removed from the bylaws. The intention of this committee was to recruit for Donna's legacy and empire (just kidding).

Today's distributed PTAC newsletter calls for nominations for next year's board members. Open Positions: President, VP Fundraising, Treasurer, Communications Secretary. For next year, Rita, Hollan, and Patricia are staying on for the silent auction.

## **FINANCIAL REPORT** (see PowerPoint presentation)
