Local Dollars for Local Schools - video

MLO - 2008 and 2012: additional \$1200 per students (this is a permanent change)

Current Bond Issue: SVVSD is growing at 800 students/yr: \$260 million (relatively smaller bond to those surrounding districts) will address school repairs / security / space for innovation centers (What it means for Niwot Elementary: bus and parking routes, internal upgrades)

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Colorado is the only state where legislature cannot raise taxes on its own.

Ammendment 23 (2010) - mandatory increase for per pupil funding: Inflation +1% for 10 yrs and then inflation only after.
